Warm Greetings from Swami Vivekananda Medical Mission


Swami Vivekananda Medical Mission is a registered Charitable Trust working with a not-for-profit motive. The trust is currently running a charitable hospital, a school, a health centre, a de-addiction centre, two skill development centres and has implemented several community development projects for the welfare of the tribal population.

Swami Vivekananda Medical Mission trust started medical relief activities in 2003 with a small dispensary at Agali. When the facility started attracting patients from far and wide, the need for a full fledged hospital was realized. The facilities were upgraded to 50 beds, with complete modern facilities of NICU, MICU, ICU operation theatre, labour room and with the addition of new wards, on the 11th of May 2023. Medicines are given free to tribes and at affordable rates to other backward people. About 200 patients visit the OP every day. Since 2016, the hospital is providing surgical services. Apart from medical treatment, general surgeries, laparoscopic surgeries, dental procedures, deliveries, emergency room services and ICU services are provided free to tribal patients.

We are herewith attaching 2 proposals, one for Swami Vivekananda Medical Mission Hospital and the other for Malleeswara Vidyaniketan School, for your kind perusal, under the philanthropic initiatives of your foundation. Detailed project information is available in the attached proposals.

1. Providing Free Paediatric Surgeries For Poor & Tribal Children Of Attappady, amounting to INR. 10,00,000/- (Ten Lakhs Only). This grant will support the treatment of 40 children from the Scheduled Tribes and the economically weaker sections of the community.
2. Support for 1-Year education of 100 underprivileged students in Malleeswara Vidyanikethan School in Attappady, amounting to INR. 20,00,000/- (Twenty Lakhs Only). This grant will support the education of children from the Scheduled Tribes and the economically weaker sections of the community.
